About the Program

The Wildwood Band Program is a parent paid program presented through the cooperative efforts of The Arts Council of the Conejo Valley, CVUSD, and The Conejo Recreation & Park District. Instrumental music can enhance your child's educational experience through creative self-expression, emotional release and satisfaction, discipline of achievement, cooperating and performing with fellow students.

At a fraction of the cost for private lessons each student will receive instruction on an instrument of his/her choice (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, bells and percussion). Students will be taught to play their instrument, read music and perform together with other student musicians. In April 2011 all band students will have the opportunity to perform in the Fred Kavli Theatre at the Civic Arts Plaza as a part of the All District Band Festival.

Fees

The fee for the program is \$330 per year paid in two installments: \$165 September 20, 2011 and \$165 February 1, 2012. Visa, MasterCard or checks* made payable to the Arts Council of the Conejo Valley (ACCV) are accepted. Students should bring the fee to the first lesson and turn it in to the instructor. In cases of financial hardship please fill out a financial aid form and pay as much of the tuition as you are able to. Payment plans are also available. A new form will need to be filled out for the 2nd installment in February. - Parents are responsible for providing an instrument and book for their child. Students will be using **Sound Innovations Book I**.
- Clarinet and saxophone players will need #2 reeds.
- The appropriate care kit for your instrument is recommended and will help keep it in working condition.
- A music stand for practice at home is also strongly recommended.
- Percussion players should rent a percussion kit.
- It is important that you rent or purchase a high quality instrument, as they are less likely to have problems. Major brands include Yamaha, Selmer, and any of the many brands sold through Selmer.
