

# 2009/2010 Wildwood School Band Program

## ATTENTION PARENTS OF 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> GRADE STUDENTS

**WHAT?** The Wildwood Band Program is a parent paid program presented through the cooperative efforts of The Arts Council of the Conejo Valley, CVUSD, and The Conejo Recreation & Park District. Instrumental music can enhance your child's educational experience through creative self-expression, emotional release and satisfaction, discipline of achievement, cooperating and performing with fellow students. At a fraction of the cost for private lessons each student will receive instruction on an instrument of his/her choice (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, bells and percussion). Students will be taught to play their instrument, read music and perform together with other student musicians. In May 2010 all band students will have the opportunity to perform in the Fred Kavli Theatre at the Civic Arts Plaza as a part of the All District Band Festival.

**WHEN?** Students receive two 30-minute lessons a week. Band will meet in the multipurpose room. Classes start Tuesday September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Beginning band meets Tuesdays from 7:30am-8:00am and Thursdays from 12:35pm-1:05pm.

Advanced band meets Tuesdays from 12:35pm-1:05pm and Thursdays from 7:30am-8:00am.

**COST?** The fee for the program is \$330 per year paid in two installments: \$165 September 22<sup>nd</sup> and \$165 February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. Visa, Master Card, American Express or checks made payable to the Arts Council of the Conejo Valley (ACCV) are accepted. Students should bring the fee to the first lesson and turn it in to the instructor. In cases of financial hardship please fill out a financial aid form and pay as much of the tuition as you are able to. Payment plans are also available. A new form will need to be filled out for the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment in February. **SUPPLIES?** Parents are responsible for providing an instrument and book for their child. Students will be using Essential Elements 2000 Book 1. Clarinet and saxophone players will need #2 reeds. The appropriate care kit for your instrument is recommended and will help keep it in working condition. A music stand for practice at home is also strongly recommended. Percussion players should either rent a percussion kit or purchase sticks and a rubber drum pad. It is important that you rent or purchase a high quality instrument, as they are less likely to have problems. Major brands include Yamaha, Selmer, and any of the many brands sold through Selmer.

Together with Principal Doug Hedin, I am proud to offer this program to the Wildwood students. I hope that you will consider taking advantage of the band program.

**What?** The Wildwood Chorus Program is a parent paid program presented through the cooperative efforts of the Arts Council of the Conejo Valley, CVUSD and the Conejo Recreation & Park District. Students will be taught proper vocal technique and music reading skills in a fun classroom environment where students work together to create beautiful music. In April 2010 all chorus students enrolled in the program will have the opportunity perform in the Fred Kavli Theatre at the Civic Arts Plaza as a part of the All District Chorus Festival.

**When?** Students receive one forty-five minute lesson a week. Chorus will meet in the multipurpose room every Wednesday from 2:40pm-3:25pm. Classes start Wednesday September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**Cost?** The fee for the program is \$180 per year paid in two installments- \$90 due September 23<sup>rd</sup> and \$90 due February 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. Visa, MasterCard, American Express or checks made payable to the Arts Council of the Conejo Valley (ACCV) are accepted. Students should bring the fee to the first class and turn it into the instructor. In cases of financial hardship please fill out a financial aid form and pay as much of the tuition as you are able to. Payment plans are also available.
